During Academic Year 2012-2013 the UPRC completed the following Program Reviews:

Anthropology, BA and MA Biology, BS and MS Economics, BA and BS Music, BA Religious Studies, BA

The following reviews are in progress:

ERM, BS Geology, BA, BS and MS Mathematics, BS and MS

The program review scheduled for Political Science was rescheduled by the UPRC and referred back to the Department Self-Study Committee.

UNIVERSITY PROGRAM REVIEW COMMITTEE ASSESSMENT ACTIVITY REPORT AY 2012-2013

The Program Review process has a variety of key components. Because the current UPRC has membership that spans 3 to 4 academic years that history has allowed the committee to identify potential bottlenecks in the process at CSUB. Therefore, in an effort to institutionalize an effective, efficient, and meaningful review process, the UPRC decided to develop a tool for data collection focused on the key components and conduct a trend analysis to establish baseline data for future assessment activity:

Data Points:

- Year/Date self- study report due
- · Number of programs submitting on time
- Number of programs requesting extensions
- Length of time until External Reviewer visit
- Length of time until External Reviewer report
- Length of time from External Reviewer Report to UPRC Report
- Length of time from UPRC Report to MOUAP

Data Collection:

Raw data for AY 2003/04 through 2012/2013 was supplied by the AVP for Academic Programs. Attached are the only comparable data kept to date.

Results:

Time frames for all three measures have been trending downward. Time to External Report has varied widely. Time to UPRC Report decreased markedly this academic year.

Action:

- The UPRC is now requesting Departments to have the External Reviewer Identified and scheduled when the Self-Study report is submitted.
- The UPRC Chair and member responsible for drafting the response have been both attending the External Reviewer Exit session. This practice may be influencing the time to UPRC report.
- Develop data collection tool to include other key process points.
- Repeat study in 3-5 years.



Additionally, the UPRC developed several goals for the year:

- a) To streamline the template----"closing the loop" on the UPRC assessment activity for 2011/2012 that found significant repetition in the template. This was accomplished.
- b) To create a timeline for interactions with programs scheduled for the next review cycle to include earlier notice, orientation/training sessions, and monitoring of progress. The UPRC is attempting to reduce the number of programs requesting extensions or submitting materials late. This was accomplished.
- c) To close the loop between the Program Review process and the MOUAP process. The UPRC now tracks the process and a representative attends post review meetings.
- d) To conduct an assessment activity of the bottlenecks in the UPRC Program Review Process. This was accomplished. Please see the attached report. The UPRC is now requesting Departments have the External Reviewer identified and scheduled when the Self-Study is submitted.

One new goal identified for the UPRC of 2013/2014 is a working relationship between campus leadership on Assessment and the UPRC---both to educate UPRC members on campus standards and expectations and to share observations on assessment activities reflected in the Self-Study process.

Finally, the discontinuance/moratorium issue identified by the UPRC in the spring of 2012 was addressed by the Academic Senate and new policies adopted.

In closing, the UPRC thanks Bruce Friedman for his service as Chair over the past two years, and thanks members Roger Peck, Robert Provencio, and Sarah Vanderlip for their valuable contributions.
