I am writing to share a few updates since we last met. Please see below.

- In the shared folder within box (referenced above), I created the initial draft of our Advisor to Advisee Survey. Please review at your earliest convenience and please share any suggested edits, revisions, additions, or the like via email - and we can discuss/make those edits prior to me creating the survey in Qualtrics. Notably, we need these edits:
 - Clear concise definitions of the three types of advisors on our campus.
 - Replace "DegreeWorks" with all CSUB like software utilized - GradesWork? PeopleSoft? RunnerConnect? etc. (see row 29)
 - Include any of the "questions to consider"? - see row 42
 - I know, I know...it is really a 6-point Likert scale...so do we want to keep all 6 options? Reduce? Add to?
 - Finally, this survey was almost solely taken from one of the surveys (attached) from the NACADA website...with minor edits to reflect unique things here at CSUB.
- I spoke with Debra Jackson regarding some questions I/we had from our last meeting. Please see Q&A below.
 - When does this survey need to go out? Ideally, in next two weeks...
 - Is there a rubric or standards we need to be mindful of as we draft the survey? No...
 - Should we submit to IRB? No...
 - Can Debra provide some sort of prize (e.g., "If you complete this survey you will be entered in a drawing for a "blank. [e.g., Starbucks card?]")? Yes, she will follow-up with options...

 - I will connect with BPA and Jennifer McCune to determine where to best ensure their feedback is heard (and possible, implemented).
 - Those of you who are "in the loop" on the possible new advising dates that may effect the academic placement holds schedule - please continue to keep us (ALT) updated on this progress.
