# Option 3 - Subject Matter Program

Did you attend a subject matter approved program as an undergraduate (bachelor's program)? Not sure if you did or didn't attend an approved program? Check on the approved program list: Subject Matter Approved Programs
If yes, request a subject matter waiver letter from the institution you received your bachelor's degree from. Include this letter in your program application to show you mensubject matter.
If no, try a different option for subject matter.
<b>Option 4 – Full coursework verification</b> Review the domains of Multiple Subject or Single Subject matter domain areas to see if you have previously taken coursework that might full the domains of one content area. All domains must be met in a content area to meet subject matter. Subject Matter Domains.

If yes, submit for a coursework verification. <u>Coursework Verification</u>
If no, try a different option.

### Option 5 – Exams

If options 1-4 haven't been checked yes, you may want to try the CSETs: Multiple Subject or Single Subject. The number of subtests varies depending on which exam you take. To register: <a href="#">CSETS</a>

### Option 6 - Exam/Coursework

If you met some of the subtests from a full coursework verification and passed some of the subtests for the CSET in the same content area, then you may want to submit for an exam/coursework verification to see if you can meet subject matter between a combination of exams and coursework.
