The Robert Noyce Teacher Scholarship Program provides funding to institutions of higher education to provide scholarships, stipends, and programmatic support to recruit and prepare STEM majors and professionals to become K-12 teachers. The program seeks to increase the number of K-12 teachers with strong STEM content knowledge who teach in high-need school districts.

Applications Typically Due: rolling

The Robert Noyce Scholarship program is a National Science Foundation (NSF) funded program that provides scholarships to students who are committed to teaching science or mathematics in high need school districts upon the completion of a single subject credential program. The CSUB Noyce Scholarship Program will offer scholarship support for up to two academic years.

**Golden State Scholarship**

The Golden State Teacher Grant program (GSTG) is for students who are currently enrolled in a teacher preparation program to earn a credential in a high need field and commit to teach at a priority school, in California for four years, within five years after completing a teacher preparation program.

GSTG awards of up to \$20,000 are available to eligible, currently enrolled students in California Commission on Teacher Credentialing (CTC) approved teacher preparation programs. Campuses and program

### Teacher Education Assistance for College and Higher Education

The TEACH Grant Program provides grants of up to \$4,000 a year to students who are completing or plan to complete course work needed to begin a career in teaching

**Eligibility:**

As a condition for receiving a TEACH Grant, you must sign a *TEACH Grant Agreement to Serve* in which you agree to (among other requirements) teach

- in a high-need field;
- at an elementary school, secondary school, or *educational service agency* that serves students from low-income families
- For at least four complete academic years within eight years after completing (or ceasing enrollment in) the course of study for which you received the grant.
