

PLACEMENT IN WRITING COURSES

Placement

Category 1	Places out of ENGL 1109 (A2)
Category 2	Places directly into ENGL 1109 (A2)
Category 2C	Places into ENGL 1109 (A2) conditionally
Category 3	Places into ENGL 1100 and 950 (Stretch Composition)
Category 4	Places into ENGL 1100 and 950 (Stretch Composition)

Students are placed in one of these categories upon admission to the university.

Prerequisites

<u>Course</u>	<u>Prerequisite</u>
English 1109	Placement in Category 2 OR Grade of D- or higher in ENGL 1100 in Cat 3 or 4 OR grade of C- or higher in ENGL 80/99/910/920 OR a passing score of 147 or above on the EPT; a score of 500 or higher on the critical reading section of the College Board SAT Reasoning Test.
English 3109*	Completion of ENGL 1109 (A2) with a C- or higher.
English 3119*	Completion of ENGL 1109 (A2) with a C- or higher.

*To fulfill the Graduation Writing Assessment Requirement (GWAR), these courses must be taken after a student completes 60 semester units of undergraduate work, and a student must earn a C- or better in the course. (See pp. 8-10 for more information on the GWAR.)

Corequisites

<u>Course</u>	<u>Corequisite</u>
English 1100	English 950

These two courses must be taken together.
