**PROMISING NEW FACULTY AWARD  
2025/2026**

**Nominations due by April 1, 2025**

The Promising New Faculty Award was established in 2016/2017 by the Academic Senate of California State University, Bakersfield in order to recognize exemplary achievements in teaching, research, scholarship, creative activities, and/or service among all full-time, tenure-track faculty.

**Nomination Process**

You are encouraged to participate. CSUB is known for its excellent faculty, and now is the time to formally acknowledge a faculty member you feel is *especially* deserving of recognition. The nomination process is simple:

Nominations must be submitted **electronically** to Julie Kang (hkang8@csub.edu) by **April 1, 2025** and include the nominee's most current abbreviated vita and a written statement not to exceed 600 words, summarizing the reasons for the nomination. The statement should be concise and factual and confined to issues related directly to the contributions, achievements, and currency as articulated in criteria for selection. The following rules apply:

- ❖ Any full-time, tenure-track assistant professor is eligible.
- ❖ Nominations may be submitted by administrators, faculty, students, or alumni. No self-nominations shall be accepted.
- ❖ The criteria for the award, as set by the Academic Senate of CSUB, call for the following:
  - Contribution: The primary criterion is outstanding, demonstrated, significant contributions to teaching, research, scholarship, creative activities, and/or service.
  - Achievement: There must be evidence that the nominee has performed work of superb achievement as demonstrated by publication or artistic production and evaluation by peer review.
  - Currency: Nominees shall be scholars who are current with developments and findings in their field and in the use of effective pedagogy.
- ❖ After receiving the nomination, the Faculty Honors and Awards Committee will reach out to the nominee's department or unit to solicit its collective decision whether to support, oppose, or take no position regarding the nomination.

The Faculty Honors and Awards Committee will select a nominee to submit to the CSUB Academic Senate for approval. The Promising New Faculty Award recipient will receive University recognition and a \$1,000 stipend.
