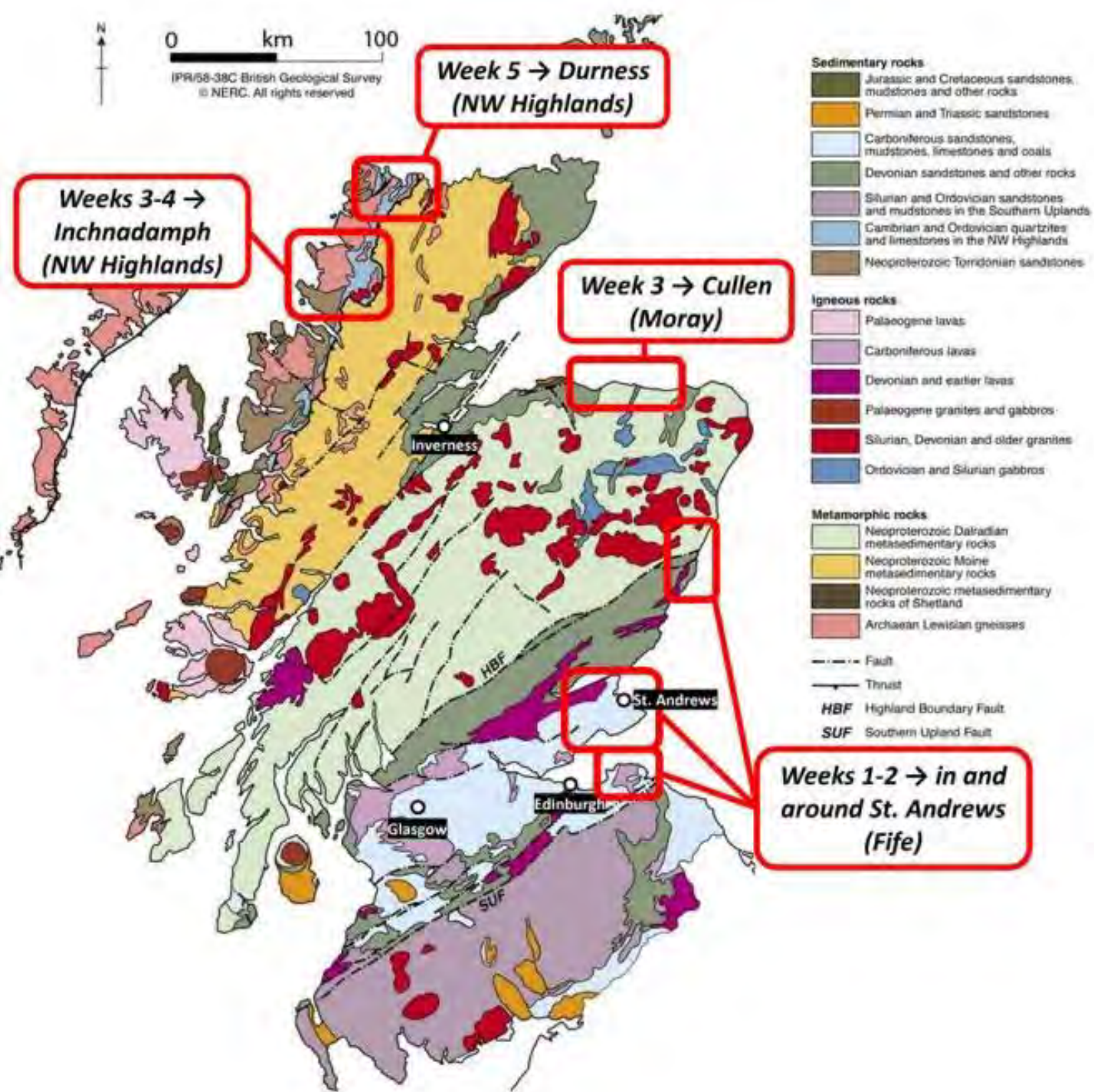


GEOLOGY FIELD CAMP IN SCOTLAND
