PowerPoint/Presentation Requirements:

Area 1: Comprehension & Content

- Effectively communicate the background and significance of the research.
- Effectively communicate the research strategy/design and the results/findings of the research.
- Provide a presentation that follows a clear and logical sequence.
- Effectively communicate the conclusions, outcomes, and impact of the research.

Area 2: Engagement & Communication

- Deliver the presentation clearly, and use language appropriate for a non-specialist audience.
- Provide a well-defined slide that enhances the presentation.
- Convey enthusiasm and capture and maintain the audience's attention.

Prizes:

- 1st place: \$400 & opportunity to present at the CSU-Wide Grad Slam.
- 2nd place: \$200 & opportunity to present at the CSU-Wide Grad Slam.
