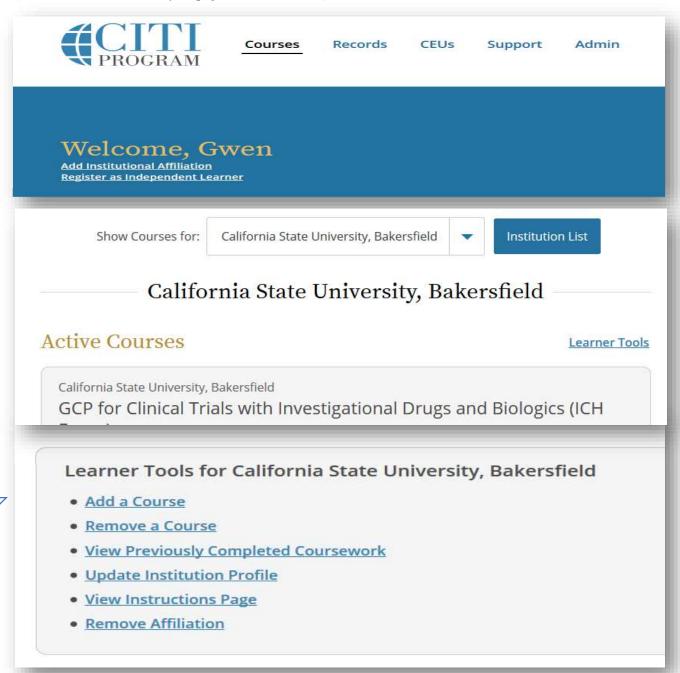

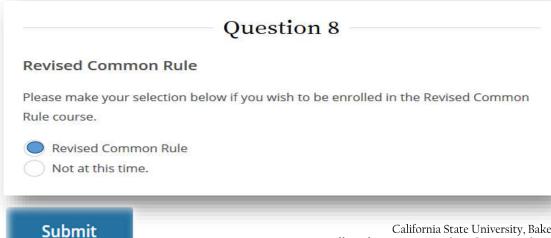

As a reminder note: The CSUB-HSIRB accepts 3 types of Human Subjects Protection Training Completion Reports for the purposes of approving an IRB Protocol:

- I. CITI-PI/Researcher SBE (Social, Behavioral, & Educational Research)
- 2. CITI- Students Conducting No More Than Minimal Risk Research
- 3. CITI-PI/Researcher Biomedical/Biomedical Data or Specimens
