Application and Poster Guidelines

The purpose of the poster presentation is to promote excellence in undergraduate and graduate scholarly research and creative activity by recognizing outstanding student accomplishments at California State University, Bakersfield. Scholars with visually organizing their ideas to present their research. Students will have the opportunity to present their posters to faculty, staff, and their fellow colleagues in short 3-5 minute increments.

1. Poster size requirements: 4' x 3' (48 inches X 36 inches) - Maximum size allowed. Poster may be presented horizontally or vertically.
2. Easels and poster boards will be provided for students to place/adhere/present their poster.
3. Research involving human or animal subjects must first be authorized by the CSUB Institutional Review Board (IRB) or Institutional Animal Care and Use Committee (IACUC). All applications will be reviewed for compliance. Contact Gwen Parnell at (gparnell@csub.edu or 661-654-6712).
4. Submit an application to participate at <https://csub.infoready4.com/> by Sunday March 29, 2026, including a short abstract of your research, scholarship, and creative activity poster.

Directive on Posters

Poster Submission: Posters must be emailed in PDF format to mbarrera@csub.edu by Monday, April 6, 2026 at 12pm. Provide full name, student id, and a contact phone number within the email submission. GRASP will coordinate with the Printshop to print all posters.

Poster Pick up: Posters can be picked up at the GRASP office in DDH 108D beginning on Monday, April 13, from 1pm on. Should you be unable to pick up your poster prior to the event, the poster will be waiting for your set up on the day of the event.
