- 🖶 The Helen Louise Hawk Honors program is a 4-year program
- The invitation to apply to the program is sent out once a year by the end of the Spring semester
- **♣** The required GPA to join the program:
 - First-year Freshmen GPA: 3.7
 - First-semester sophomores GPA: 3.5
- The required GPA to remain in the program: 3.2
- The invitation to join the program is <u>not</u> currently extended to CSUB juniors and seniors nor transfer students
- ♣ The invitation to apply to the program is sent to following 3 groups:
 - FIRST-YEAR FRESHMAN: WITHOUT AP OR Dual Enrollment credits
 - FIRST-YEAR FRESHMAN/1st SEMESTER SOPHOMORES: WITH AP AND/OR Dual Enrollment credits
 - FIRST-YEAR FRESHMAN/1st SEMESTER SOPHOMORES: WITH Upper Division Thematic Courses Exemption
- ♣ The Honors courses are designated as sections 21, and they are blended with the non-honors sections
- ♣ Honors sections 21 are strictly reserved for the Helen Louise Hawk Honors Program students with no exceptions for any other kind of honors students
- During the four years of their studies at CSUB the Helen Louise Hawk Honors students <u>are required</u> to successfully complete SIX honors requirements:

FIVE honors designated courses (section 21)

• 2 GE Lower Division

- 2 GE Upper Division
- JYDR

HIP: Honors individual Project—this is to be completed in the last semester of their studies at CSUB
