



Techniques to Promote Academic Integrity

Non-Technical Solutions

- Address expectations for academic integrity in the syllabus. Provide a link to the policy: <https://www.csub.edu/osrr/Academic%20Integrity%20/index.html>
- Ask students to sign an “oath of honesty.”
- Make one question on a test a statement that “I am doing my own work.”
- Make changes in assignments from term to term and class to class.
- Ask questions that require analysis of specific situations.
- Ask questions that require application of concepts to specific situations or to student-specific variables.
- Require students to explain their test answers.
- Require video recordings of skill demonstrations.

Technical Solutions

- Randomize the order in which students receive questions.
- Set time limits per question.
- Limit the opportunity to revisit questions.
- Monitor the testing procedure via Zoom.
