Estimated Program Costs

Post Acceptance Requirements

Students must meet clinical placement requirements. Unless otherwise noted with further instructions, all other items listed may be initiated.

⚠ Drug Screening (<u>time -sensitive</u>)—<u>Login to Verified Credentials for Instructions</u>

As a condition of final acceptance and enrollment to the nursing program, students are required to pass a designated drug/alcohol screening at the student's expense through a contracted agency with the Department of Nursing.

⚠ Background Screening & Licensure Eligibility (<u>time -sensitive</u>)—<u>Login to Verified</u> Credentials for Instructions

As another condition of final acceptance and enrollment to the nursing program, students are required to submit to and complete a background check. This is at the expense of the student through a contracted agency with the Department of Nursing.

Clinical Requirements

CSUB Traditional BSN curriculum includes clinical rotations in local hospitals. Kaplan Package

HealthStream

The Department of Nursing is partnering with HealthStream to provide students with their required clinical training modules. These modules are necessary prior to students starting their clinical rotations in the hospital. More information is coming soon with registration instructions. Save proof of completion of modules to submit to Canvas in the Nursing Communication Center.

Nursing Student Attire

In the Newly Admitted Students portion of the website, you should have reviewed the <u>Guidelines</u> <u>for Professional Appearance</u>. Nursing scrubs and attire may be ordered through Personally Yours Embroidery. Order forms can be found on the <u>Newly Admitted Student</u> portion of the nursing website. **Personally Yours Embroidery** is a local vendor located in Bakersfield. Students need to place orders at least 3 weeks before the due date (must wear uniform for August 18th Orientation). University Admissions

Final updated transcripts must be received in the Office of Admissions by the deadline of **July 15**th to finalize your admissions. If your transcript shows in progress courses in the fall, you will need to drop those classes prior to sending official transcripts. Advising and Class Registration

On or around mid-July, the Department of Nursing will enroll you into your first semester nursing courses and remove your **Advising Hold**. Be sure to clear all other holds on your account as it will block you from being registered into classes. If you are a continuing student and enrolled for *other classes* for the Fall at CSUB, **you will be dropped from all the courses** to accommodate the required NURS courses: NURS 2110, 2111, 2120, 2121, and BIOL 3220 (Patho, for those still need it). Additionally, a book list will be available once you are enrolled in classes.

Students will be assigned to a Faculty Advisor by the start of the fall semester. The Department of Nursing will be working on student's academic/advising outlines. These should be available to you and your faculty advisor and by the start of the advising period in the Fall for Spring 2026 course planning.
