Who we are:

Community Preventive Health Collaborative (CPHC) is an extension of the CSUB Nursing Program.

What we do:

CPHC has been created to meet a need in the community. We provide health education and administer health screenings to detect elevations in blood pressure, cholesterol, glucose levels, and body mass index, in order to educate and refer individuals to appropriate health services. Follow-up will be made

by students in the program to encourage those referred individuals to seek primary medical care for their potential conditions.
