Hello, P2P Requestors,

Important P2P Updates:

- Receiving Requirement Update: The Chancellor's Office P2P Team modified the system so that low dollar, low risk
 transactions for goods purchased from punchout suppliers like Amazon and Staples, no longer require receiving by
 Distribution. Instead, the PO Owner (Requestor) will receive a request for approval to "verify receipt" which is the
 same one-click process completed for services. Any discrepancies on goods received vs ordered needs to be noted
 via comments to Payment Services so they are aware and then PO Owner will work with the supplier to correct the
 discrepancy.
- High-risk, high dollar purchases will still require receipt in P2P by Distribution. See the diagram below for items that will continue to be received in P2P.

- · Please note, as this is a systemwide change, campuses do not have the ability to revert back to the old process.

2-Way Match

Receipt NOT Required.

PO Owner Approval (Verify Received)

- The PO Owner approves the voucher IF:
 - · It is NOT an Asset Item
 - It is <u>NOT</u> a High-Risk Commodity (below)
 - It is <u>NOT</u> identified as "Receiving Required"

3-Way Match Receipt Required.



Receipt Requirement

- A receipt is required IF the item falls into any of these categories:
 - Asset Item
 - · High-Risk Commodity (below)
 - · Identified as "Receiving Required"
- Hold for Receiving will <u>remain</u> at 30 days
