  - a. Chair Danforth called the meeting to order at 10:04 AM.
- 2. Announcements and Information
  - a. EC Faculty Only: December 10 Provost Search Listening Session; TBD, virtual.
    - i. Preference for 11:00 AM. The Senate Analyst will contact the President's Office to confirm the time. Discussion ensued regarding the appropriate process, i.e. the search committee should be present at the listening session and will need to have their first meeting.
  - b. Campus Event: December 9 Special Budget Open Forum; 11:00 AM- Noon, Student Union MPR and virtual.
  - c. January 31 (tentative) Spring General Faculty Meeting
    - i. Discussion ensued regarding the date, length of the meeting, and anticipated attendance. Some concerns raised by Vice-Chair Solano about the meeting taking place after classes have started, which impacts attendance. Chair Danforth and the EC support the meeting to take place January 31, which is after the Board of Trustees and ASCSU have met and the release of the Governor's Budget. This will allow for there to be more information that can be shared regarding the budget situation, and other pending items. The Senate Analyst will confirm the President and Interim Provost's availability and finalize the date.

    - The Office of the Provost have successfully hired a new staff member, Patty Padilla. Interim Provost Rodriguez directed the Senate Office to copy Leslie Williams, as well as Patty Padilla on future communications. Patty will also be providing support regarding his calendar when Leslie is not available.
    - 2. The Arts and Humanities Dean Search is underway. Interim Provost Rodriguez has met with the Arts and Humanities Advisory Committee regarding the Arts and Humanities Associate Dean search. They discussed that the search committee will need to be formed following the appropriate processes for the election of faculty members to serve on the committee.
    - 3. Discussion ensued regarding the upcoming budget forum and strategies for addressing enrollment concerns.
