

Artificial Intelligence Committee (AIC)

Function: The AIC is tasked with assessing how AI technologies may impact pedagogy, research, student learning outcomes, and the student learning experience. The AIC will establish ethical guidelines for AI usage, development, and deployment and produce recommendations regarding AI technology implementation, training, policies, and procedures. The AIC will report its recommendations to the Information Technology Committee (ITC) for prioritization and implementation.

The membership of the AIC shall include: one full-time faculty member elected from each College, one at-large full-time faculty member appointed by the EC, one faculty librarian appointed by the EC, one selected ASI representative, the Dean of Students, and the Director of Instructional Development. Members are expected to serve for two-year terms on a staggered basis, as needed. Additional members may be added to the AIC at the discretion of the Information Technology Committee (ITC).
