

Intercollegiate Athletics Advisory Committee (IAAC)

The Intercollegiate Athletics Advisory Committee (IAAC) is advisory to the President in the oversight of intercollegiate athletics as required by NCAA policy. The IAAC reviews the policies and scope of operations of intercollegiate athletics to assure their consistency with the University's academic mission and vision. The committee also reviews the extent to which the department collaborates with other University units and departments to: (1) integrate student-athletes into the general student body; (2) promote student-athlete welfare; and (3) facilitate student-athletes' academic success, retention, and graduation. In addition, the committee reviews the compliance of intercollegiate athletics with institutional, conference and NCAA policies and regulations. A majority of the committee voting members must be faculty. Two routine meetings per academic year. Appointments are for a staggered three-year term.
