1. Call to Order

a. Chair Danforth called the meeting to order at 10:02 AM.

2. Announcements and Information

- a. January 31 Spring General Faculty Meeting
 - i. Chair Danforth shared the list of topics and issues that were shared with President Harper for discussion at the GFM. Additional topics to discuss include addressing concerns with the pause on federally funded loans and grants and how it affects the campus community; addressing metrics regarding class cancellations; the status of graduation initiatives; details regarding current outreach activities; fundraising strategies; exorbitant last minute event charges for IT support (\$3500) and campus contract with PacWest; shared governance, specifically pertaining to the permanency of certain MPPs. There was some discussion regarding the modality of future GFMs considering the increase in cost. The EC supports the request by the deans to attend the GFM Open Session.

 - 1. AS&SS discussed referral 2024-2025 25 Academic Advising Structure and Report. T. Tsantsoulas reported that the discussion that took place was uncomfortable and some individuals on AS&SS voiced their feelings that Senate was overreaching. They also discussed having the Interim Director of Advising consider tailoring her report to consider this question. Chair Danforth: Advisors would not exist if the programs did not exist and therefore the program faculty have oversight over academic advising.

 - 1. RES 242515 Bylaws and Handbook Changes in Response to ASCSU Constitution Ratification. FAC is working on this resolution and had a few questions. FAC is proposing to add the lecturer electorate representative as a new seat on Senate, not to take any of the at-large seats. Some discussion ensued regarding if it would be a new seat on EC or not and the term length. N. Michieka suggested considering policies that are in place for adding and removing ASCSU seats. For example, CSU SLO and Maritime are merging. There may be another future constitutional change that needs to be ratified if they decide to formalize the language in the ASCSU constitution.

 - i. Z. Zenko discussed the minor change to the resolution including striking out the clause referring to the use of masks. Vice-Chair Solano suggested adding in "CSU" to the title for clarification. The EC agreed on the changes. The resolution will be added for second reading to the Senate agenda for Thursday. This is a statement resolution that they do not necessarily expect President Harper to sign.

 - 1. Discussion ensued regarding how class cancellations are managed across the colleges and the inconsistencies. Interim Provost Rodriguez confirmed there have not been any updates regarding the 1972 memo that was distributed last year regarding program cancellations. Some members of EC expressed that if there is a degree being offered, then there is a commitment to the students that those classes will also be offered. There was also concern about how class

cancellations are also affecting student graduation. A set of guidelines and/or philosophy on how course cancellations are handled should be developed. This item will be referred to the subcommittees for discussion and clarification on how class section class cancellations are managed.
