RATIONALE: The Nursing Department currently offers nursing degrees in both undergraduate and graduate levels. The Nursing Department is proposing a new certificate program of Post Graduate Nurse Educator that prepares nurses with graduate degrees to deliver outstanding, evidence-based nursing education as well as sit for the NLN Certified Nurse Educator (CNE) examination.
