COVID Updates

The deadline to turn in Vaccine and/or Vaccine booster information is February 28th. People who are late may find themselves locked out of Canvas.

Religious and Medical exceptions are accepted, please go the following link and follow the instructions to turn in your Vaccine or exception form:

If you choose to be exempted, you will need to be tested for COVID-19 on a weekly basis. The COVID-19 Testing Center is now located in the **Student Union Multipurpose Room**. The testing site is open from **7 am – 7 pm Monday – Thursday, and 8 am – 12 pm on Friday, walk-ins welcome.**

The testing is a saliva test, **DO NOT** eat or drink anything an hour prior to testing. **IF YOU TEST POSITIVE** you will be asked to quarantine for 5 days. If you are asymptomatic, by the end of those 5 days you can test again, if the test is negative, you may return to campus.
